
SUBMITTING A LAND CLAIM

Electronic and print versions of the following items should be included in the land claim submission:

- Statement of land claim, including allegations that are clear and detail Ontario's involvement in the events leading to the claim
- A historical report that includes:
 - An executive summary
 - Footnotes, or endnotes, indicating the document in the document collection that is being cited to support statements in the report
- Documents used to support the historical report, numbered sequentially (e.g. 1, 2, 3, etc.)
- Document index listing the number, date, author and brief description of each document used
- List of research sources consulted
- Numbered maps (if maps are relevant to the submission)
- Map index (if maps are included in the submission)
